CARPENTRY Secondary

PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE

DURATION: 6 HOURS

Assess the contestant's ability to accurately and safely complete certain carpentry tasks using generally accepted carpentry practices.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

Quality, accuracy, and attention to detail while performing tasks necessary to complete project.
Site housekeeping, Ability to safely work to deadline.

PRE-REQUISITES

Work planning skills. Ability to read plans and specifications. Ability to do trades math.
Proficient in the safe use of hand and power tools.

EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, SUPPLIES, AND CLOTHING

The following clothing and protective gear must be supplied and worn by the contestants for the competition. If you are not able to provide your own, please write on your registration form what you need:

CSA approved hard hat
CSA-approved safety boots
Safety eye wear
Hearing Protection (supplied)

Contestants must wear the appropriate clothing: no loose or baggy clothing that could cause an accident.

NOTE: The contestant will not be allowed to compete if the above Personal Protective Equipment is not used.

Competitors must supply their own:

- Carpenter's level 4'-0
- Measuring tape (imperial and metric)
- Calculator (non-programmable)
- Lead pencils
- Erasers
- Carpenter's hammer

Contestants will be provided with:

- Framing square
- Cats paw (nail puller)

- 25 feet, three prong extension cord
- Power Miter Saws
- 7 1/4" Circular Saws
- 3/8" Cordless Drills
- 3/8" Cordless bits
- 3" Nails.
