PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE

DURATION: 6 HOURS

To evaluate proficiency and creativity in the television/video communication field.

Teams may have 1-3 people per team (please note only teams of two are accepted at the Territorial Skills Competition so those advancing will have to form teams of two).

A limit of eight teams will compete in this contest.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

On the day of the competition, shoot and edit a 2 to 4 minute video based on the following scenario: You are a team tasked with producing a story about the Skills Canada NWT Regional Skills Competition. Take any approach and find any aspect as long as the story is informative, entertaining, and appropriate for a general audience.

- Camera
- Audio
- Editing
- Storytelling
- Teamwork
- Time management
- Problem solving
- Literacy

- Analyze news stories and documentaries
