PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE

DURATION: 3.5 HOURS

To assess and determine the beauty treatment interests/needs of the customer and to provide beauty treatment care that enhances the person's physical appearance and psychological well-being.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED

Manicure:

- examine hands and fingernails
- record observations on a technical chart
- prepare fingernails using appropriate procedures and instruments
- perform hand and arm massage
- apply a base coat, apply two coats of red, and top coat with no bleeding

Facial Care:

- assess and analyze facial skin needs
- record observations on a technical chart
- perform a basic facial treatment including facial massage
- recommend a follow up home program

Note: candidates are not required to memorize product names, however, they must use generic terms denoting the action of the product (ex: hydrating mask)
